

West Coast Jayco Club

By-Laws

February 2019

1. Eligibility

To be an Ordinary Member of the West Coast Jayco Club a member must own a Jayco Recreational Vehicle (RV).

Associate Membership is open to past members who:

- (1) Have resigned due to ill health
- (2) No longer own a Jayco RV.
- (3) Have left the club but still have their Jayco RV and are pursuing other interests that do not allow them to meet the required number of rallies.

2. Financial Year

The financial year is to be from 1st January to 31st December.

3. Membership Year

The Club's membership year shall be from 1st January to 31st December

4. Recreational Vehicle Limit

The Club shall be limited in size to 35 Jayco Recreational Vehicles

5. Cooling off period

For Ordinary Members there shall be a cooling off period lasting 6 weeks after an applicant attends their second rally. During this time either the Committee or the applicant may cancel the membership without need to provide a reason.

6. New Members – Attendance at Rallies

New Ordinary Members must attend 2 rallies within 6 months of joining. If this is not done, the Committee may, at its discretion, cancel the member's application and refund all monies paid.

7. Minimum Attendance

To renew membership, an Ordinary Member must have attended 3 rallies in the previous 12 months. Members are exempt from this requirement if they provide prior written notice to the Committee that they will not be able to attend the required number of rallies in a financial year.

8. Maximum Attendance (Associate Members)

Associate Members may attend a maximum of 3 rallies per year.

9. Refunds

Members must reimburse the Club for any money forfeited or paid on their behalf as a result of their non-attendance at a club rally, function or activity.

10. Pets

Members are not permitted to bring animals to club rallies, functions or activities.

11. Committee Membership

10.1 The President of the Club shall be the Chairperson of the Committee.

10.2 The Vice President of the Club shall be the Deputy Chairperson of the Committee.

10.3 From any member couple in the club, at most one person can serve on the Committee of this Club at any one time.

12. Guests

Members may invite guests (non-Members) to attend no more than two rallies per financial year. Prior to the rally, members are to contact the Committee through either the President, Vice President or Secretary to advise of the proposed guests. Attendance to be limited to no more than 6 guests in any one rally. Guests must sign the Rally Attendance register. Guests are not permitted to attend Club Birthdays or Christmas Rallies unless invited by the Committee.

13. Dependents

Members are permitted to bring their children less than 18 years of age and any person in their care with special needs to Club Rallies. Members are fully responsible for the behaviour and actions of their dependents attending Club rallies.

14. Complaints

Any complaints must be made to the President or Secretary in writing.

15. Smoking

Smoking is not permitted at the Club rallies and functions.
